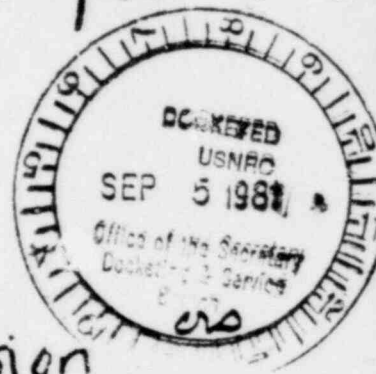

Dear Director, Nuclear Regulatory Commission

I am writing you to let you know of my opposition to the opening of the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant. My reasons for this stance are as follows:

- (1) because of the expense of the plant itself - it has increased in expense greatly from its original cost.
- (2) due to the location of the plant - in close proximity to an earthquake fault.
- (3) because the money used to run this plant could be put to more productive use, such as solar and wind power, which are not nearly as great a threat to the environment.

I urge you not to license this plant, taking into consideration the above concerns which are shared by a great number of U.S. citizens (and fellow world inhabitants. I'm certain you will be reminded of this when protests are organized in the near future. Your response is appreciated. Thank you.
