

MEMO TO ASLB AND PARTIES REGARDING WITHDRAWAL OF COUNSEL:



Effective October 15, 1981, I m withdrawing as counsel for Intervenor in the above-captioned proceeding. This action is necessitated because I am moving my law practice at that time from Los Angeles to Northern California. I hope that my withdrawal from this case will be only temporary, but I will not be able to make that determination for certain until after resettling in the north.

The Nuclear Law C nter is currently searching for replacement counsel. In the interim, Mr. Daniel Hirsch, President of the Committee to Bridge the Gap, has been authorized by the CBG Board to represent it in the case and authorized to sign all necessary documents. During this period he will receive informal advice from the Nuclear Law Center, until formal counsel can be arranged. I trust, however, that he will be afforded the consideration generally granted <u>pro se</u> representatives in NRC proceedings.

At a meeting of the Board of the Committee to Bridge the Gap on September 24, the withdrawal of Mark Pollock as counsel in the UCLA reactor case was announced.
