This refers to the routine inspection conducted by Dr. L. L. Friedman of this office on August 28-29, 1980 of activities authorized by NRC License Nos. 08-01709-04, -Of and -O7 and to the discussions of our findings held by Dr. Friedman with Dr. J. Stapleton and others of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.


The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your licenses as they relate to addition safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and the conditions of your licenses. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personne, and observations by the inspector.

In addition, the inspector made independent measurements of the radiation output of your teletherapy unit using ionization chambers. These measurements were made as part of our ongoing program of evaluation of the performance of teletherapy units as documented in Bulletin 76-08, which was sent to you in August 1976. Our measurements agree within 0.1% of the value used for treatment purposes. Our value is consistent with your measurements and is within acceptable limits.

Our inspector also verified the steps you had taken to correct the Items of Non-compliance brought to your attention in the enclosure to our letter dated October 17, 1979. We have no further questions regarding your action at this time.

Within the scape of this inspection, no items of noncompliance were observed.

In accordance with Section 2.790 c? the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter will be placed in the Public Document Room.
