Re: Hydrology Topics Pertaining to the Sand Rock Mill Project - NRC Docket No. 40-8743

Dear Mr. Fleming:

Thank you for your September 21, 1981 letter to me from Dan E. Martin which provided an evaluation of the non-hydrological facets of the Sand Rock radiological baseline program. I noted that this letter indicated further evaluation would be forthcoming concerning the surface and groundwater portion of this program. Your prompt attention to the evaluation of the adequacy of the water data will be appreciated.

In our September 25 telephone conversation, you proposed that Conoco meet with you on October 14, 1981 in your Silver Spring offices to discuss certain problem areas in the Sand Rock Mill hydrology work. Recall that Conoco does not have any written summary of the areas of discussion at this time. The potential problem areas were first discussed in a telephone call to Conoco (J. Cearley and D. Bollig) on July 29, 1981. I understand that some of the problem areas may have been addressed by your consultant (Ott Water Engineers) in their mid-September report to you.

Please be advised that Conoco requires at least five working days notice prior to the proposed meeting to study whatever hydrological concerns the NRC has at this time. Therefore, I am requesting that written confirmation of areas of discussion be provided promptly so that Conoco may adequately prepare for the October 14 meeting.
