On January 9, 1981, Houston Lighting and Power provided a list of planned submittals to NRC, Planning and Program Analysis staff, covering the calendar years 1981, 1982, and 1983 (a copy is attached).

In September, 1981, Houston Lighting and Power announced its intention to make significant changes in the role of its architect engineer and construction manager for the South Texas Project (STP). This planned change will result in a revised STP construction schedule and consequently will necessitate a revision to many of the programmed activities transmitted in January, 1981. A revised schedule for the project and resubmittal of an updated planned submittal list will be available on or before September 1, 1982.

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
