Dear Mr. Eisenhut:

Generic Letter No. 81-27, dated July 9, 1981, requested Florida Power Corporation to notify you of any information submitted with our Emergency Plan implementing procedures which contain privacy or proprietary information that should be deleted before release to the public document room. Florida Power Corporation hereby provides notification that certain information previously submitted should be withheld from public disclosure and, therefore, not released to the public document rooms.

Our Emergency Plan implementing procedures were submitted to you by letter dated February 27, 1981. Included in our submittal was a copy of Emergency Plan Implementing Procedure EM-206, "Emergency Plan Roster and Notification," Revision 18, dated January 28, 1981, which contains private telephone numbers and addresses of officials who would be notified during an emergency.

Disclosure of such information would clearly represent unwarranted invasion of privacy for these persons and could have a detrimental effect upon emergency response as suggested in Generic Letter 81-27. Florida Power Corporation, therefore, requests that you delete Enclosures 1 and 2 of EM-206 before placing our procedure into the public document room.
