Areas inspected: Included a review of Security Plan and Procedures; Security Organization - Management; Security Organization - Personnel; Security Organization - Response; Records and Reports; Testing and Maintenance; Locks, Keys and Combinations; Security System Power Supply; Lighting; Access Control - Personnol; Access Control - Packages; Access Control - Vehicles; Detection Aids - Protected Area; Detection Aids - Vita? Area; Follow up Items on Previous Inspections; and Independent Effort. The inspection involved 98 inspector hours by two NRC inspectors. The inspection was begun during regular nours; 30 inspection hours were accomplished during off shift periods.

Results: The licensee was found to be in compliance with NRC requirements within the sixteen areas examined during the inspection.
