This memo confirms our notification of the subject prompt notification reportable occurrence made Thursday, October 22, 1981, to Mr. H. C. Dance of your office as follows:

OCCURRENCE

On Wednesday evening, October 21, 1981, a routine periodic test performed during partial draining of the primary system at the beginning of a planned refueling outage revealed that the flow path associated with the boron injection tank was obstructed.

CORRECTIVE ACTION

The flow path was re-established by alternating pump operation and raising the thermostat settings for the related heat tracing. A flow path to the hot legs was verified to be operable by establishing flow and the unit was in cold shutdown condition.
