Subject: Reactor Protection System (RPS) Power Supply

Dear Sir:

In Reference (c), Vermont Yankee committed to install redundant Class 1E protection at the interface of the non-Class 1E power supplies and the RPS. The schedule for this modification was proposed assuming timely receipt of qualified equipment. Vermont Yankee ordered the necessary material early in March of 1981, and delivery was scheduled for September 11, 1981.

We have recently been informed by the vendor that qualified equipment will not be available in time to implement this change during our 1981 refueling outage. We have requested that this equipment be qualified and provided as soon as possible. We intend to install this modification during the first outage of sufficient duration following receipt of qualified equipment.
