On July 10, 1981, Gulf States Utilities Company (GSU) responded to I&E Bulletin 81-03, "Flow Blockage of Cooling Water to Safety System Components by <u>Corbicula</u> sp. (Asiatic Clam) and <u>Mytilus</u> sp. (Mussel)." This letter reported the presence of Asiatic clams in the vicinity of River Bend Station (RBS) and also listed the components and systems potentially affected by the bivalve mollusks. GSU committed to perform an assessment of the components and systems for their adequacy to prevent or detect fouling.

To prevent larvae and clam infestation, RBS design provides for chlorination treatment at the service water and circulating water pump discharges. GSU expects the RBS upflow clarifiers to be effective in removing addit clams.

The result of the preliminary assessment is that the existing instrumentation is adequate to detect flow blockage in each system. Depending on the system, combinations of the following types of instrumentation may be used at RBS: 1) flow elements, 2) air flow switches, 3) temperature indicators, 4) pressure indicators, 5) temperature modulating valves with position indication, and 6) inlet and outlet pressure sensing devices or differential pressure measurements.

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The preliminary results of our assessments are being confirmed. GSU anticipates this final revision to be completed by December 2, 1981.
