

RE: JAMES A. FITZPATRICK NUCLEAR POWER PLANT

Reference: (a) Letter from J. P. Bayne to T. A. Ippolito dated April 10, 1981

We have reviewed your proposed modification (reference (a)) for the subject Action Item. The criteria used in our review were:

- 1. All level instruments should be referenced to the same point.
- Licensees should commit to modify documenta n, including operating procedures and transical specifical is, as required, to reflect the new reference level.
- Licensees should commit to provide appropriate training for plant operators.

Our review did not encompass a human factors evaluation of your water level instrumentation (e.g., placement, legibility, etc.). That evaluation will be performed as part of the detailed control room review (Action Item I.D.1) that you will be expected to conduct per NUREG-0737 and NUREG-0700.

We find that, while your modification is an acceptable interim measure with respect to the July 1, 1981 implementation date, it does not completely resolve the concern upon which this Action Item is based. The rationale of Action Item II.K.3.27 is that the operator should not have to perform mental interpolations to understand what a reading on one water level indicator means relative to a reading on another water level indicator. Your modification makes information readily available that the operator needs to perform a mental interpolation, but it does not eliminate the need for performing the interpolation.

Therefore, we request that you submit within 30 days of receipt of this letter:

- 1. Your commitment to install a modification that provides a common reference level during your fall 1981 outage and
- A request for modification of your license that includes proposed technical specification changes, as required; a description of the modification; and your commitment to meet acceptance criteria 2 and 3 above.
