## NRC STAFF'S STATUS REPORT ON OPEN SSER ITEMS

On November 5, 1981, the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board (Board) issued a Telegraphic Message addressed to the parties in this proceeding which read as follows:

> Applicant's Motion to Establish Hearing Schedule is Denied. Suffolk County Snall Report Status of Legislative Action of Sixth Stipulation by November 25. Staff Shall Advise by November 25 When Open Items in SSER and ACRS Letter will be Closed. Confirmation will Follow in Order.

Applicant's "Motion that a Hearing Schedule be Set" was filed on October 6, 1981. The NRC Staff in a response dated October 26, 1981, supported Applicant's proposed hearing schedule. However, Staff noted that Applicant's proposal was premised on approval by the Suffolk County Legislature of the Stipulation concerning the County contentions advanced in this proceeding. Staff recognized that if the stipulation is not approved, the hearing schedule proposed by Applicant will have to be adjusted. To date the Suffolk County Legislature has not voted on the stipulation in question. Set out below, as requested by the Board, is a status report on the open items identified in the Supplement to the

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Safety Evaluation Report related to the proposed operation of the Shoreham Nuclear Power Station, Unit No. 1, which was issued in September,  $1981.\frac{1}{2}$
