Subject: Inspection 30-11363/81-01

This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Mr. J. Nicolosi and Ms. M. Campbell of this office on October 15, 1981 of activities authorized by NRC License No. 08-16631-01 (expired) and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Nicolosi with yourself at the conclusion of the inspection.

The area examined during this inspection was limited to the circumstances pertaining to your expired byproduct materials license. Within this area, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

Based on the results of this inspection, it appears that one of your activities was not conducted in full compliance with NRC requirements, as set forth in the Notice of Violation, enclosed herewith as Appendix A. This item of noncompliance has been categorized into the levels described in the Federal Register Notice (45 FR 66754) dated October 7, 1980. You are required to respond to this letter and in preparing your response, you should follow the instructions in Appendix A.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter and your reply will be placed in the Public Document Room.

Also, you must immediately place the radioactive material on hand in secure storage until such time as you acquire a valid license. No other use of the material on hand or purchase of additional byproduct material is authorized. Include a statement in your reply to this letter confirming that you have taken this action and describing the controls that will be exercised over the stored material until such time that you obtain a valid license.


