Gentlemen:

Pursuant to 10 CFR Parts 50.51 and 2.109, we respectfully request a renewal of our facility license, as described in the application dated August 30, 1957, and subsequent amendments thereto, including Amendment No. 11 dated November 10, 1975.

The new requested term for License R-56 is for a term of 22 years, expiring at midnight on December 23, 1999.

The University of Florida Training Reactor has been operated successfully and safely for over 18 years at the University of Florida Campus. Periodic improvements and modifications of the reactor systems have been performed during these years, all of which have contributed substantially to the safe and reliable operation of the facility. Within the present term of the operating license, the UFTR was equipped with a new control console and instrumentation, new primary and secondary cooling systems and instrumentation and very complete Reactor Protection System and Radiation Monitoring System. Also, the UFTR has been a leading university facility in providing the administrative requirements, regulations and security procedures effectively to operate the facility and to safeguard the health and safety of the public.
