I. SECY-81-595 - PG&E Motion for Reconsideration of Diablo Canyon Order

The Commission unanimously approved an order denying the motion by Pacific Gas and Electric Company seeking reconsideration of the Commission's decision directing the Licensing Board to include low-power contentions 10 and 12 in the full-power proceeding. (OGC)

(Subsequently, the Secretary signed the Order.)

II. SECY-81-594 - Publication of "Guidelines for the Management of Agreement State Radiation Control Programs"

The Commission unanimously approved a modified notice entitled, "Guidelines for NRC Review of Agreement State Radiation Control Programs." This statement of policy is being issued to inform the states and the public of the criteria and guidelines which the Commission recommends for the management of agreement state radiation control programs.

The Commission:

1. approved publication in the Federal Register of a modified notice circulated November 12, 1981, to be effective on the date of publication;

2. requested that states be furnished copies of the Policy Statement;
(SP) (SECY Suspend: 12/13/81)
3. requested that appropriate Congressional committees be informed;
(SP/OCA) (SECY Suspend: 11/30/81)
4. requested that a public announcement be issued when the Policy Statement is filed with the Office of the Federal Register;
(SP/OPA) (SECY Suspend: 11/30/81)

5. requested that the EDO contact the Department of Labor to determine if the annual redeterminations of the adequacy and compatibility of regulatory programs of the agreement states should be terminated and, instead, provide DOL with the results of the 18-month reviews; and (EDO) (SECY Suspense: To be determined)
6. requested that staff develop for Commission consideration by February 1, 1982, a draft of performance-based indicators for these guidelines. (SP) (SECY Suspense: 2/1/82)
