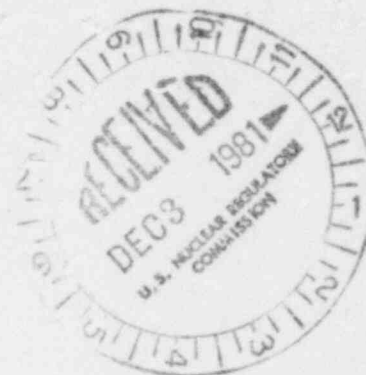

Millstone Nuclear Power Station, Unit No. 1
NUREG-0737 Item II.K.3.44, Evaluation of
Anticipated Transients Combined with Single Failure

In Reference (1), the Staff informed Licensees and Applicants referencing the BWR Owners Group response to NUREG-0737 Item II.K.3.44 that the report had been accepted as sufficient on a generic basis. Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO), on behalf of Millstone Unit No. 1, docketed this report in Reference (2). Reference (1) also requested NNECO to confirm that the assumptions and initial conditions used in the report are representative of Millstone Unit No. 1. This letter is being docketed in fulfillment of the Staff's request.

NNECO has reviewed the analysis assumptions and initial conditions used for the generic analysis and concluded that they are representative of Millstone Unit No. 1. As such, no further action is required and the Staff's concerns of NUREG-0737 Item II.K.3.44 are resolved.
