COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA'S
MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME FOR
FILING OF PROPOSED FINDINGS OF FACT AND
CONCLUSIONS OF LAW ON CONTENTIONS 6 AND 20

The deadline for filing of proposed findings and conclusions by intervening parties is December 2, 1981. The Commonwealth received the Applicant's proposed findings and conclusions, comprising 123 pages, just prior to the Thanksgiving weekend. In addition, counsel for the Commonwealth has been involved in litigation of the TMI-1 Restart Proceeding five days a week. Therefore, the Commonwealth requests an extension for the filing of proposed findings and conclusions on the emergency planning contentions (6 and 20) until Monday, December 7, 1981.

The only two parties affected by this Motion are the Applicant and the Staff. Counsel for both the Applicant and the Staff have no objection to this Motion.

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
