YELLOW CREEK NUCLEAR PLANT UNITS 1 AND 2 - QUALITY ASSURANCE AUDIT M80-7  
DEFICIENCIES 2, 3, 5, AND 14 - FIFTH INTERIM REPORT

Deficiencies 2, 3, and 5 were initially reported to NRC-OIE Inspector M. Thomas on September 23, 1980 in accordance with 10 CFR 50.55(e). A first interim report was submitted on October 23, 1980. Since that time, construction quality assurance audit deficiency 14 was also considered to be a significant condition adverse to quality. This was followed by our interim reports dated November 25, 1980, March 20, and September 24, 1981. TVA is still in the process of reviewing the subject deficiencies. We expect to submit our next report by February 23, 1982.
