This letter concerns our application for amendment of our Byproduct Materia's License 34-00054-05, currently under review as Control Number 80990. The requested amendment would permit the possession incident to distribution of a new lamp product which contains a glow switch which in turn contains 0.1 microcuries promethium-147. These lamps will be purchased from an overseas supplier, Toshiba of Japan, and imported into the U.S. The majority of the stock will be located at our Ravenna, Ohio Distribution Center and shipped from there to our other distribution points. The lamps will be received as a completed product and no manufacturing or modification to the product will be done after receipt. These lamps will then be distributed by us to commercial/industrial and consumer users as an exempt item under 10CFR30.15.

We have also identified a similar lamp product available from a second supplier, Matsushita of Japan. The Matsushita lamp's glow switch is identical in design to the Toshiba product, but contains a greater amount of promethium-147, 0.33 microcuries per switch. We would like to amend our license so that lamps from either supplier may be imported and possessed incident to distribution. This would require amending our license to permit possession of:

glow switches, 0.1 microcuries per switch, 75 millicuries total, and

glow switches, 0.33 microcuries per switch, 85 millicuries total.

Other aspects of our license will remain the same. We will be using the same Distribution Centers that are already covered under this license. We are also amending our license which covers distribution of products containing radioactive materials to accomodate the new product line as well.
