
For both items of non-compliance identified in paragraphs 1 and 2 in your correspondence we have taken the following corrective steps.

- 1. Radiopharmacy personnel have been advised of the inspection results. It was explained to them the importance of maintaining survey records to comply with the conditions of our NRC license. This was presented to each responsible individual and is documented as such.
- 2. Corrective steps that have been taken to avoid further violation consist of assigning a backup person who will be responsible for insuring the surveys are conducted in the event the primary surveyor is not available due to illness or other absence. Hopefully this will prevent any further omissions in our survey records.
