We are in receipt of your correspondence dated January 26, 1990 pertaining to the inspection of our facilities upon January 10-11-1990 by D.R. Gibbons. In response to your notice of violation, we would like to offer the following corrective action.


For both items of non-compliance identified in paragraphs 1 and 2 in your correspondence we have taken the following corrective steps.

1. Radiopharmacy personnel have been advised of the inspection results. It was explained to them the importance of maintaining survey records to comply with the conditions of our NRC license. This was presented to each responsible individual and is documented as such.
2. Corrective steps that have been taken to avoid further violation consist of assigning a backup person who will be responsible for insuring the surveys are conducted in the event the primary surveyor is not available due to illness or other absence. Hopefully this will prevent any further omissions in our survey records.


3. Full compliance will have been achieved by approximately February 9, 1990, at which time it is expected the inservice will be completed.
