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Gentlemen:

This refers to our February 26, 1990, Limited Modification of Order Suspending Licenses (Limited Modification) and your February 27, 1990, request for approval of Mr. Donald Soldan to serve as an authorized independent consultant for American Radiolabeled Chemicals (ARC). Your letter also indicated ARC's desire to use Mr. Soldan as the Radiation Safety Officer and health physicist to potentially supervise and oversee the decontamination of the laboratory, subdivision of materials, and preparation of shipments.

We have reviewed Mr. Soldan's qualifications and find them acceptable. However, since ARC is currently only authorized to receive, repackage and distribute licensed materials and is not authorized for any subdivision or synthesis of licensed materials or decontamination of the laboratory, we will approve Mr. Soldan, at this time, only for the supervision of repackaging and distribution of licensed materials. This approval is specifically contingent upon incorporation of language in his independent consulting agreement identical to that approved by the NRC in the February 26, 1990, Limited Mod'fication.

Therefore, in accordance with the February 27, 1990, request, as modified above, and pursuant to Section IV of the January 11, 1990, Order Suspending Licenses, paragraph 3 of the February 26, 1990 Limited Modification is amended to read as follows:

Exhibit A, "Shipping Instructions," Section 1.b, shall be modified to read "Shipments may only be prepared under the supervision and in the physical presence of Joseph Zlotnicki, Lee Ann Borcherding, Donald Soldan or any other individual specifically approved for this activity in advance by the Commission."

All other provisions of the February 26, 1990, Limited Modification remain in effect except as provided above.

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With respect to your request for approval of Mr. Soldan for subdivision or decontamination of the laboratory, we will defer acting until we receive and evaluate your response to the request for additional information in the February 26, 1990, Limited Modification. Please include in your response a detailed description of the respective roles and interrelationships between Mr. Soldan, Mr. Zlotnicki, and Ms. Borcherding in subdivision and laboratory decontamination activities.

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
