On February 28, 1990, Florida Power and Light Company (FPL) met with the NRC to discuss its plans for resolving the subject licensing issue. In that meeting, the NRC found FPL's approach and schedule for issue resolution to be generally acceptable, and FPL committed to submit its conceptual system design for staff approval. Enclosed is the conceptual design.

FPL is proceeding with procurement and detailed engineering activities. Expeditious NRC review and approval of this conceptual design is requested to permit system installation in the time frame discussed in our February 28, 1990, meeting.

FPL has determined that the enclosed material does not contain safeguards information as defined by 10 CFR 73.21 due to the nature and/or content of this submittal.

FPL is prepared to meet with you, as necessary, to support your review.
