
SUBJECT: PROPOSED LICENSE TO EXPORT REACTOR  
MATERIAL TO CANADA (XMATO343)

On March 2, 1989, NRC received a license application from Aldrich Chemical Company to export 14,550 kilograms of deuterium oxide, for upgrading in Canada and returned to the U.S. for use in NMR Work.

The applicant has requested expeditious processing of the license request as the material is ready for immediate shipment and is urgently needed.

The staff has concluded that the proposed export meets the requirements of the Atomic Energy Act and would not be inimical to the common defense and security of the United States.

In view of the above considerations, the staff issued the license without the normal 30-day waiting period.
