The purpose of this letter is to document the implementation of the Priority III Human Engineering Discrepancies (HEDs). This letter was requested by NRC Licensing Project Manager Timothy Colburn for closure of this item (Reference 3).

Detroit Edison committed to complete Priority III HEDs by the end of the third refueling outage (Reference 2). The remainder of the Priority III HEDs were completed prior to or during the third refueling outage. Therefore, Detroit Edison considers this item to be complete and ready for NRC closure.
