NOTICE OF DEVIATION

During an NRC inspection conducted on February 18-19, 1993, a deviation of your commitment was identified. In accordance with the "General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Action", 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C, the deviation is listed below:

By letter dated December 10, 1992, Sequoyah Fulls Corporation (SFC) responded to a NRC Notice of Violation dated November 23, 1992. SFC stated, in part, that a document would be developed which establishes a shipping program for hazardous materials. SFC further stated that procedures would be established to govern the shipment of hazardous materials. The date when these actions would be completed was specified as December 31, 1992. By letter dated December 31, 1992, SFC stated that due to current staffing levels, a commitment to revise facility procedures to adhere to the program document on transportation of hazardous materials must be extended from December 31, 1992, to February 15, 1993, to allow time for revision, review, and approval.

Contrary to the above, by February 16, 1993, SFC had not completed implementation of all of its corrective actions. Specifically, the document which established a shipping program had not been approved. Further, of the 14 procedures that SFC had identified for review and revision to implement the shipping program for hazardous materials, only seven had been completed.

Please provide to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, ATTN: Document Control Desk, Washington, D.C. 20555, with a copy to the Regional Administrator, Region IV, in writing within 30 days of the date of this Notice, the reason(s) for the deviation, the corrective steps which have been taken and the results achieved, the corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further deviations, and the date when your corrective action will be completed. Where good cause is shown, consideration will be given to extending the response time.
