Gentlemen:

This is a request for amendment to the above referenced license.

During a compliance inspection the week of June 24, 1963, it was brought to our attention that the licensed material in our possession and described in paragraphs 6G, 7G, and 8G of the above referenced license is in fact in excess of the possession limit authorized.

The license application, dated April 19, 1960, used the manufacturer's description of "approximately 200 millicuries" each, and we were licensed accordingly. However, the batteries received actually contained more than 200 millicuries. In order to be in compliance, we request amendment of maragraph 8G to read "Three batteries not to exceed 350 millicuries each, total not to exceed 950 millicuries." (Two sources are 350 millicuries, one is 250 millicuries.)

We also request deletion of J. Kastner from Condition 13 of this license. Dr. Kastner is no longer in our employ.

We regret that an oversight at receipt three years ago has resulted in noncompliance and feel that our current ordering and receiving procedures, as well as better control measures by suppliers, will prevent a recurrence.
