
REF: TU Electric letter logged TXX-93135 from Mr. William J. Cahill, Jr. to the USNRC dated March 24, 1993

Gentlemen:

During a telephone conversation on April 5, 1993, with your Region IV staff, TU Electric agreed to supplement and clarify the response to the Notice of Violation which was submitted via the above referenced letter.

TU Electric has reviewed the reasons for the violation, and concurs with your staff that; one of the principal causes for the violation was that TU Electric did not invoke the operations procedural requirements for the work performed. Since the system had been turned over to Operations, and was not under the custody of Startup, a work order in accordance with Station Administration procedure STA-606 "Work Requests And Work Orders" should have been issued.
