Dear Sir,

I am a solo practitioner and had a small nuclear lab in the office. This lab remained closed effective 01/12/87 due to financial reason. In September 1989 I had heart attack followed by heart bypass surgery. My heart attack was complicated by weak heart. After several months of total disability I came back part time and started to work full time since April '92. I received a bill from Nuclear Regulatory commission for the first time in in early october 1991. I was not aware of the license fee change prior to this date. We called Nuclear Regulatory commission in Chicago the same day we recieved our bill and were advised to cancel my license. NRC form 314 was subsequently received and filled up and the license was terminated on 11/18/91. On October 5th, 1992 I received a bill from PAYCO copy of which is attached. We sent a copy of termination of our license to PAYCO.

With my bad health and financial difficulties I would appreciate if you could kindly write off the license fee. I have not done any nuclear test since later part of 1986. Our CS-137 sealed source was given to Hackley Hospital on 04/06/87.
