Dear Mr. Yeager:

This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Mark Mitchell of this office on March 16-25, 1993, of activities authorized by NRC Byproduct Material License Nos. 24-16652-01 and 24-16652-02, and to the discussion of our findings with you and members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, independent measurements, and interviews with personnel.

In addition to the above areas, the inspector examined actions described in your letter dated March 25, 1991 and April 17, 1991, regarding violations found during our February 12, 1991 inspection. We have no further questions regarding these matters.

During this inspection, certain of your activities under License No. 24-16652-02 were found to be in violation of NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Notice. A written response is required. No violations of NRC requirements were identified for License No. 24-16652-01.

One other violation was identified in addition to the violations described in the enclosed Notice, namely your failure to submit a complete copy of your quality management program as required by 10 CFR 35.32(f)(2). This violation will not be subject to enforcement action because your efforts in identifying and correcting the violation meet the criteria specified in Section V.G. of the Enforcement Policy.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the Commission's regulations, a copy of this letter, the enclosure, and your response to this letter will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.

The response directed by this letter and the accompanying Notice are not subject to the clearance procedures of the Office of Management and Budget as required by the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980, PL 96-511.
