On April 8, 1993, San Luis Obispo Mothers for Peace ("SLOMFP") filed its Response to Memorandum and Order [Addendum to FES]. It was a 2 1/2 page document responding to the Licensing Board's questions. On April 14, 1993, Pacific Gas and Electric Company ("PG&E") filed a Motion to Strike in Part SLOMFP Filing Regarding Addendum to FES. PG&E went into a 2 1/2 page tirade about the SLOMFP's "long argument regarding the need for an EIS." PG&E Motion to Strike at 2. For the record, SLOMFP reaffirms that it has a legitimate argument. In its response to the Board's second question, SLOMFP explains its view that the generic methodology used to produce the Environmental Assessment is inadequate and why. This response was responsive to the Board's questions and SLOMFP has every right to reply in this manner; PG&E's motion to strike in part SLOMFP filing regarding the Addendum to FES should be denied.
