Reply to a Notice of Violation, Dated April 19, 1993



This letter is in reply to a Notice of Violation that was identified on a routine safety inspection conducted by S. Wagner on March 30, 1993, of activities authorized by NRC Byproduct Material License No. 34-01572-08.

The violation noted was a failure to post current copies Parts 19 and Part 20, the license, license conditions, documents incorporated into the license, license amendments and operating procedures or a notice describing these documents and where they may be examined, as specified in 10 CFR 19.11 (a) and (b).

The violation was an oversight on our part and we have posted a notice on April 20, 1993 describing these documents and where they may be examined. In order to assure we are in compliance with all NRC 10CFR regulations we plan to have our Radiation Protection Officer attend a refresher NRC training a minimum of every two years.
