SUMMARY

Scope:

This routine, announced inspection was conducted in the area of Physical Security Program for Power Reactors; specifically, Management Support; Security Program Plans; and Audits; Protected and Vital Areas Barriers; Protected and Vital Area Access Controls of Personnel, Packages and Vehicles; Alarm Stations and Communications; Compensatory Measures; and Security Training and Qualification. In addition, the licensee's Special Nuclear Material Control and Accountability Program was reviewed to verify compliance with regulatory requirements and licensee commitments.

Results:

In the areas inspected, violations or deviations were not identified. Review and observation of security operational activities and tours of security facilities confirmed that the management and operational effectiveness of the security program was being maintained as noted during previous inspections. Continuing efforts to further enhance the efficiency and performance standards of the security force were evident. Inspection results indicated that the security force was adequately trained and equipped, was professional, and capable of providing an adequate level of protection for the plants' vital and safety related equipment.
