Gentlemen:

Pursuant to the Initial Decision issued September 4, 1962 and my telegram of the same date Item 3.a.(1) of License DPR-2 was amended to authorize Commonwealth Edison Company to operate the Dresden reactor at steady state power levels not in excess of 700 megawatts (thermal). A copy of that amendment, designated as Amendment No. 7 and the notice thereof which will be published in the Federal Register is enclosed.

Also enclosed is a complete revision of the Technical Specifications (Appendix "A") of License DPR-2 which incorporates the increases in the maximum heat flux limits and steady state power levels authorized by the aforesaid Initial Decision and telegram.

Pursuant to Section 2.761(c) of 10 CFR Part 2, the Initial Decision remains subject to review by the Commission for a period of thirty (30) days after issuance.
