Dear Secretary,

I am writing in regards to your proposal to ease regulations binding enrichment plants (News release in the Federal Register of Oct. 27, 1980).

The idea of reducing contamination by mixing radio-active scrap metal with other metals, resulting in a "recyclable" metal alloy, is to me foolish, unsafe and exceedingly short sighted.

It is my understanding that you consider the health effect to be minimal. I believe that you are wrong. Radiation, no matter how small the dosage, has a lasting and accumulative effect.

I urge you to reconsider this proposal, indeed, to re-evaluate all existing regulations concerning the disposal of nuclear wastes in a safe and rational manner.
