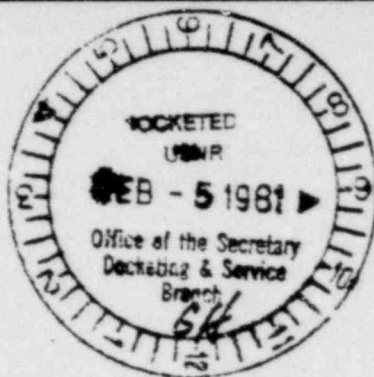

I am writing to protest your proposed deregulation of certain radioactive medical and research wastes and the permitting of their disposal in sewage systems and sanitary landfills (FR 67018). Also, I protest the proposal to allow the recycling of some radioactive metals by allowing them to be smelted and mixed with uncontaminated materials for use in consumer articles (45 FR 70874).
