Dear Mr. Kinneman:

This is to inform you of the actions we have taken to bring us into compliance with the Interim Enforcement Policy, 45 FR 66754.

Effective July 22, 1981, all personnel in our laboratories will be required to account for all licensed materials discarded through the sanitary sewage system as well as that placed in storage at the time that such disposal is made. Each isotope will be recorded separately and the data will be collected each week. The amounts of licensed materials discarded then will be deducted from the running inventory of isotopes maintained in the laboratory in order to ensure that at no time do we exceed the allowable levels of licensed materials.

I believe that these actions should serve to bring us into full compliance with the regulations.
