The proposed Licensee Event Reporting (LER) Rule 10 CFR 50.73 was submitted to the Committee to Review Generic Requirements (CRGR) for consideration. In view of previous Commission directives in affirmation of SECY 81-494. Integrated Operational Experience Reporting System dated August 18, 1981. including the requirement for AEOD to develop the proposed rule by December 31, 1981, the CRGR did not review the proposed rule.

The CRGR recommends that the proposed rule go forward to the Commission for consideration even though the Committee did not have the opportunity to obtain a complete review package addressing the factors identified in the Chairman's memorandum to you dated October 8, 1981, and outlined in more detail in the CRGR Charter. However, the Committee believes that the proposed reporting requirements are significantly interrelated with other proposed reporting requirements and with requirements already imposed on licensees, including the provisions of newly revised 10 CFR 50.72, the requirements incorporated in licenses in accordance with NUREG 0654. Criteria for Preparation and Evaluation of Radiological Emergency Response Plans and Preparedness in Support of Nuclear Power Plants, and reporting requirements contained in Standard Technical Specifications for Reactors. In order to assure that the Commission is provided a comprehensive review of the interrelationship between these many reporting requirements, we recommend: (1) that the appropriate offices coordinate an outline of the various existing and proposed reporting requirements and a plan to assure their coordination, and (2) that this outline and plan accompany the proposed rule to the Commission.
