Subject: XCOM0288 License Amendment Application: Korea.

Dear Mr. Devine:

General Atomic Company (GAC) makes application, pursuant to 10 CFR 110, for amendment to subject license to extend expiration date by three years. The present expiration date is December 31, 1981. The proposed new expiration date would be three years from date of issuance. We also request that the total value of items to be exported be increased from \$150,000 to \$200,000.

GAC is engaged in the manufacture and sale of nuclear reactors, nuclear instrumentation systems, components therefor, and cooperative research in the development and testing of the components and fuels for research reactors. In the normal servicing of our research reactors we are required to provide replacement equipment and materials. The initial export of items on this license has been delayed and it appears that we will not be able to ship within the time limit of this license. It is also anticipated that we will have a continuing need to export such parts and equipment and will require a valid license for such shipments.

We request that you amend this license accordingly at your earliest convenience.
