APPARENT OVEREXPOSURE TO AIRBORNE CONCENTRATIONS OF DEPLETED URANIUM

Nuclear Metals is licensed to process depleted uranium into kinetic energy penetrators for use by the military. This requires cutting, turning, extrusion, grinding and drilling of depleted uranium metal. Licensee urinalysis results indicate that an employee involved in grinding operations in April 1981 may have received an exposure to airborne depleted uranium in excess of the limits of 10 CFR 20.103. Uranium concentrations in urine as high as 935 micrograms per liter were detected at the time and the employee was temporarily removed from work involving the depleted uranium. A ung scan in October, 1981 indicated the presence of 8 milligrams of depleted uranium in the lungs. The exposed individual was examined by a physician shortly after the April incident and was given permission by the physician to return to work. The Regional office is now evaluating the bioassay data and may employ a medical consultant.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts has been notified. A press release will be issued when the occurrence of an overexposure is verified. There has been no media interest. The NRC learned of this incident during a safety inspection on December 1, 1981. The results of the inspection are being evaluated for enforcement action.
