The Board has before it contested motions by the Intervenors Christa-Maria, <u>et al</u>. and John O'Neill to further defer their responses to the pending Licensee's and Staff's motions for summary disposition, and for clarification of time to file written testimony or, alternatively, for an extension of time to file.

Upon consideration of all of the matters raised in the motions and responses thereto, and upon all matters of record, it is this 14th day of December, 1981

ORDERED

That all responses to the pending summary disposition motions and prefiled testimony on the issues not covered in the motions for summary disposition shall be filed on or before January 25, 1982, with no further extensions granted except under the most extraordinary circumstances. Staff and Licensee are given until January 25, 1982 to amend their prefiled testimony or add to it if they desire. Intervenors are put on notice that a failure to file on time may result in the Board's deciding the pending issues only on the basis of the timely-filed papers, or dismissing the issues on which no timely responses or testimony have been filed for failure to file, without considering the merits.
