In our letter of February 9, 1979, AP&L submitted justification to do a reduced differential pressure test on certain valves to meet the requirements of 10CFR50, Appendix J. Subsequent to the above, AP&L either made modifications to the valves in question or devised testing equipment to allow full pressure testing. Therefore, AP&L hereby withdraws the February 9, 1981, request for NRC approval of a reduced differential pressure test on valves CV-4446, SF-43, SF-44, CV-1053, CV-1214, and CV-1216.
