This is to amend our letter of March 19, 1980, concerning the export of 13.342 kg of U_{235} contained in 14.3 kg of total uranium.

Above original quantities of special nuclear material have to be increased as follows 13.364 kg of U_{235} contained in 14.330 kg of total uranium.

Part of this quantity, namely 10.565 kg of U_{235} contained in 11.330 kg of total uranium will be used for the fueling of the FRJ-reactor. The remaining 3.0 kg of material will be fabricated into irradiation test samples to be inserted in the Community research reactors listed in our letter of March 19, 1981.

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All the other data of our letter of March 19, 1981, remain unchanged.
