Answers of Intervenor Salava To Applicants' Interrogatories" were
filed on October 8, 1981. The "Answer of Intervenors, Christy and
Salava, To Motion To Compel Answers To Interrogatories" was filed

October 23, 1981. Subsequently, the Board directed the parties to
attempt to resolve their discovery disputes informally.

Counsel for Applicants and counsel for Ms. Christy and Ms. Salava have discussed the matter, but agree that Board action will be necessary for the isposition of Applicants' motions, to the extent that those motions seek to compel responses to interrogatories on emergency planning issues. Counsel for Ms. Christy and Ms. Salava has agreed, in a telehpone conversation with counsel

*/ One of Intervenors' main arguments is that they should not be required to respond to discovery requests on their emergency planning contentions until the emergency plans have been formally adopted by the respective governmental bodies. Applicants disagree with the merits of Intervenors' position. See Applicants' Motions, at 2-3. However, Intervenors' concern with respect to the Coffey County plan has been rendered moot. The Coffey County Commissioners recently approved the county plan; an updated copy of that document is being provided to counsel for Intervenors under separate cover.

Accordingly, Applicants renew their motions for orders compelling Ms. Christy and Ms. Salava to respond fully to Applicants' Interrogatories EP-4, EP-5, EP-7, EP-8, EP-9, EP-11, EP-12, EP-15 and EP-16, and Interrogatory EP/FQ.
