Sequoyah Nuclear Plant unit 2 operating license condition 2.C(16).p requires TVA to submit the analysis for model justification being revised by the Westinghouse Owners Group (WOG) for calculations for small-break LOCAs. However, Westinghouse has informed us that additional effort is required to complete revision of the small-break LOCA analysis model and that the revised model will not be available to TVA until April 1, 1982. Therefore, for reasons beyond our control, we will not be able to comply with the January 1, 1982 date for submittal of the model justification. Following TVA review of the revised model, we anticipate being able to submit the model justification on or before June 1, 1982.

Accordingly, we request that you revise the Sequoyah Nuclear Plant unit 2 operating license condition 2.C(16).p to reflect this new date because of the delay in the Westinghouse Owners Group effort.
