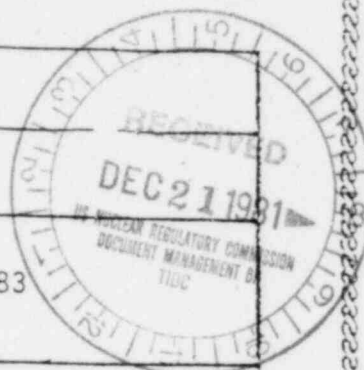


SPECIAL NUCLEAR MATERIAL IMPORT LICENSE
