ORDER TERMINATING PROCEEDINGS

I

Hospital of Philadelphia, College of Osteopathic Medicine, 4150 City Avenue, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania 19131 ("the licensee") is the holder of Byproduct Material Licenses 37-06855-01 and 37-06855-03 ("the licenses") issued by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("the Commission"). Licenses 37-06855-01 and 37-06855-03 authorize the possession and use of byproduct materials under certain conditions specified therein. License 37-06855-01 was originally issued on November 1, 1960. The present expiration date of the license is November 30, 1982. License 37-06855-03 was originally issued on January 31, 1978 with the present expiration date of January 31, 1983.

II

On March 26, 1981, the licensee's activities authorized by Licenses 37-06855-01 and 37-06855-03 and located at 4150 City Avenue, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, were inspected by a representative(s) of the NRC Office of Inspection and Enforcement for health and safety purposes. On July 29, 1981, the Commission sent Invoice 1081N to the licensee requesting payment within 30 days of the inspection fee of \$460 required by 10 CFR 170 of the Commission's regulations. A second notice of payment due, together with a Notice of Violation was sent to the licensee on

September 2, 1981. A final notice of payment due was sent to the licensee on October 2, 1981. The licensee failed to respond to three invoices. Consequently, on November 23, 1981 the Chief, License Fee Management Branch, Office of Administration, issued an Order to Show Cause ("the Order"), directing the licensee to show cause why the license should not be revoked permanently. As an alternative to filing an answer, the Order provided that, if payment of the fee were made within 20 days of the date of receipt of the Order, the Director of Administration or the undersigned would issue a subsequent Order terminating the revocation proceeding. In response to the Order, the licensee followed this alternative procedure and paid the inspection fee of \$460.

III

Accordingly, in view of the payment of the inspection fee under the terms of the Order and, pursuant to the Commission's "Rules of Practice" in 10 CFR Part 2, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

This proceeding is terminated.
