Consistent with section 2.790(b)(1), any such application must be accompanied by an affidavit executed by the owner of the information which identifies the document or part sought to be withheld, and which

contains a full statement of the basis on which it is claimed that the information should be withheld from public disclosure. The section further requires the statement to address with specificity the considerations listed in 10 CFR 2.790(b)(4). If we do not hear from you in this regard within the specified periods noted above, the report will be placed in the Public Document Room.
