SUBJECT: FLOOD RISK AT THREE MILE ISLAND

Your memorandum of May 24, 1979, requested NRR's comments on the treatment of flood risks at Three Mile Island. The issues had been raised by Mr. R. J. Wallis, President-elect of the Hydrology Section of the American Geophysical Union, in a letter to Chairman Hendrie on May 18. 1979.

A xerox copy of the response to Mr. Wallis is attached. The response deals not only with the issues for Three Mile Island, but also speaks to the generic issue of flood risk assessment at nuclear power plants. To augment the information on the generic aspects, I have also attached the Research Requirements package which initiated the investigation mentioned in the response. This package summarized the purrent staff practice for estimating floods, and identifies research needs related thereto.
