1. Forwarded for your consideration is license application for the repair/rework of magnesium-thorium components of the J79 jet engine. The operation, to be located at Tinker AFB OK, will replace the operation currently conducted at Kelly AFB TX, under USNRC License STB-837.

Although no work shall be performed prior to receipt of a license, the current projected start-up is in February 1982, but may be changed accordingly.
